1. SCOPE AND APPLICATION

This regulation applies to companies certified by NCERT S.R.L., hereinafter referred to as NCERT.

2. USE OF REFERENCES TO NCERT CERTIFICATION

Companies certified by NCERT are entitled to use references to NCERT certification, limited to the activities covered by the certificate. The NCERT logo may be used by the aforementioned parties in offers and contractual documents, and on the website, solely to provide information about the scheme covered by the certification obtained, and only if they hold a valid certificate.

3. USE OF REFERENCES TO ACCREDITATION

Individuals and companies certified under ACCREDIA accreditation are also entitled to use the ACCREDIA logo, in compliance with what is set out in Regulation RG 09, Regulations for the Use of the ACCREDIA Mark, in its current revision, according to the configuration shown in Figure 3 of the same RG 09 Regulation.

In particular:

- a. The certified individual or company must never use the ACCREDIA Mark separately from NCERT's certification mark.
- b. The ACCREDIA Mark must not be used in a way that suggests ACCREDIA has certified the individual's competencies or the company process, or in any other misleading way.
- c. The NCERT Mark and the ACCREDIA Mark must never be affixed, whether separately or together, to products manufactured or supplied by certified organizations, or to their packaging, wrapping, or accompanying information.
- d. The ACCREDIA Mark, jointly with the NCERT mark, must never be placed on staff business cards.
- e. The ACCREDIA Mark, the NCERT mark, and even the combined mark, must not be used in any type of technical documentation that could in any way refer to the product when the organization holds a certified management system, for example declarations of conformity for CE marking purposes, test certificates, and so on.

4. IMPROPER USE OF CERTIFICATION

The use of the Certification is considered improper if it is likely to mislead potential users of the professional services provided by individuals certified by NCERT and of the products or services offered by companies certified by NCERT.

In particular, the use of the Certification is improper when:

- it has not yet been officially granted, or its cancellation has been notified;
- it is used for activities other than those for which it was issued


